Contact Lens Policy

- Contact Lenses are medical devices and have certain risks associated with them. These risks include eye irritation, discomfort, infection, pain decrease in vision possible permanent loss of vision. To minimize these risks it is necessary to wear and replace your lenses as directed by your doctor.
- The follow fees cover reasonable care that is required to allow safe, long term contact lens wear. If your doctor determines that your situation requires additional follow up including medical eye care there may be additional charges.

<u>Annual spherical lenses evaluation fee</u> (No astigmatism)	\$70
<u>Annual Toric lenses evaluation fee</u> (With Astigmatism up to -2.25)	\$80
<u>Annual monovision evaluation fee</u>	\$100
<u>Annual Bifocal evaluation fee</u> (up to 3 follow up exams)	\$125
<u>Annual RGP evaluation fee</u>	\$150
<u>Specialty lenses evaluation fee</u>	\$ _____
